

Student Dress and Appearance Code Pre-Primary/Primary

1. Proud of LICS – Proud of Me

At LICS, we value highly the pride we have in ourselves and our school. **Brand LICS** reflects our image and the high standards that we strive to uphold.

Our uniform items and how we wear them and how we carry ourselves, while embracing the realities of a bustling progressive school and a more informal mode, must be worn with dignity and with respect towards the image of the school.

The following points must be adopted as the basic tenets for wearing our uniform:

- Students not upholding the LICS dress and uniform code will face appropriate sanctions as defined by each department.
- The uniform must at all times be worn with regard to the principle of modesty and appropriateness.
- Clothes should always be neat and freshly washed and ironed. Seams, buttons, and hems must be in good repair. Faded and worn items must be replaced.

PE / Activities / Sportswear		
The following items may be worn <u>only</u> for PE or appropriate activities:		
- PE: LICS Warriors shirt, LICS Warriors shorts, LICS school hat, trainers, LICS navy leggings - Matches: LICS Warriors shirt, LICS Warriors shorts, LICS sports socks, trainers, LICS navy leggings - House events: LICS house shirt, PE shorts, trainers, LICS navy leggings - Swimming: LICS swimming costume and swimming cap		

3. General Rules about Dress and Appearance

The following regulations apply, **without exception**:

1. All daily wear must be **worn correctly** to and from school on all occasions. Students are expected to wear their uniform with pride in as well as outside of the school environment.
2. All uniform items and valuables brought to school must be **clearly marked** with the student's name.

3. When it is essential that a student wear something other than the correct uniform, e.g. because of illness or injury, the school must be consulted for advice on what is acceptable and a doctor's note provided as appropriate.
4. LICS navy leggings are permitted under girls' skorts or shorts.
5. Students travelling home from sports practice and fixtures should wear their appropriate sports uniform.
6. When students leave the classroom at the end of the day, they should be wearing their uniforms correctly.
7. All hats must be removed in the classroom or when entering a building.
8. When attending interviews or meetings with the Head of School, Principal and/or teachers, the school uniform must be worn.

4. Appearance

4.1 Boys

- No outlandish hairstyles will be allowed. Hair should be kept neat, clean, tied back if longer than shoulder length and a natural colour.
- Permitted jewellery - wristwatch and medical alert chain/bracelet. Other, for religious reasons, by school approval.

4.2 Girls

- No outlandish hairstyles or extravagant accessories are allowed. Hair should be kept neat, clean, tied back if longer than shoulder length and a natural colour— no brightly coloured braids.
- Permitted jewellery - one simple sleeper or stud per earlobe, wristwatch and medical alert chain/bracelet. Other, for religious reasons, by school approval. Students may be requested to remove these items for PE, matches, Science or Art activities for health and safety purposes.
- No make-up or nail varnish is to be worn whatsoever.
